



ORIENTATION PROGRAMME ON RURAL DEVELOPMENT FLAGSHIP PROGRAMMES

&

ENABLING DIGITAL PAYMENT IN RURAL INDIA IN THREE DISTRICTS OF MAHARASHTRA

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAMME:

1) To orient the participants on the various flagship programmes of the MORD.

2) To orient the participants on various tools of Digital Payment.

The training will be conducted accordingly as per the Training Dates submitted herewith.Trainings will be conducted at Block Level of various proposed districts

These programs intend to bring awareness and devise methodologies that address issues of women and farming entrepreneurs. Rural India has significant impact on the economic progress of the country, and with the emerging changes of ICT penetration, and the impact of demonetization, alongside the digital initiatives carried out for rural segments, the need for improving the trends of digital payments model in rural India is very important. Considering the benefits like transparency in transactions, scope for curtailing parallel economy and improving the ease of business, it is very essential that the transformation towards digital payments, even in the rural economy, is empowered. Some of the revolutionary developments in the recent past like launch of many digital wallets like - Paytm, Mobiwik, Free Charge etc. and government launching many UPI

(united payment interface) solutions and BHIM app for smooth transition to digital payments, there are significant developments taking place.

As per the proposal submitted and approved by the ministry there are 327 training Programmes were organized in 29 blocks of 3 districts of Maharashtra 13515 trainees. In each training Programme 40-41 participant's attendance was ensured. Trainees were selected from the villages as per the desired indicators. The training was conducted in the block office at regular intervals. The training was conducted from March 2022 to April 2022. The training was divided into sessions as per schedule and everyday field visits also conducted at the last an hour. In every block training is conducted under the Chairpersonship of block Chief PD of the district development officer & BDO. In the last session of first the team take participants for the field visit in the nearby village for field visits in which the faculty chose a site in which MGNREGA work has done so the practical discussion can be made and the doubts of the participants can be discussed and doubts can be waived. Three days Training Programme for "Orientation Programme on Rural Development Flagship Programmes" to orient

the participants on the various flagship programmes of the MoRD in three districts of Maharashtra i.n. Kolhapur, Sangli, Sindhudurg, covering Twenty nine Blocks.

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES AND OBJECTIVES SOUGHT TO BE ACHIEVED: -

The programme is being proposed with the following endeavors:

- 1. The participants will be able to know the concept, approaches for development of rural areas
- 2. The participants will know the different flagship programmes of the government
- 3. The participants will know Promoting cashless transactions to strengthen rural economy
- 4. To orient the participants with various tools of Digital Payment like Aadhar Enabled Payment System (AEPS), Mobile Banking through USSD, Mobile Wallets, Point of Sale (POS), UPI etc.
- 5. There will be a three day residential training program at the block level.

Targeted Beneficiaries

The residential training will be conducted in three districts i.e., Kolhapur, Sangli & Sindhudurg covering Twenty-nine Blocks (29) & Two Thousand Six Hundred Five village panchayats (2605). The participants are PRIs of Village Panchayat (01), SHGs (02), Asha & Anganwadi workers (02). So, from every village panchayat there will be five participants who will also participate in a training programme. Total participants targeting 13,515 Participants (40 - 45 participants per programme) and duration of training is three days.

Block Level Training: The participants were Member of the village council, Member of Village Development Bodies, SHGs, Women Organization and Youth Organization targeting.

Women were the primary recipients of the training programme, which served the dual purposes of empowering women for national development and equipping those in positions of authority with more professional skills in order to better utilize their positions of responsibility and power for the benefit of the government and society as a whole.

MINISTRY of RURAL DEVELOPMENT, Government of India granted funds under Recurring grants to SIRDs for the financial year 2022-23 and Hamara Sankalp is implementing partner for conducting training programs over the year on prescribed schedules.

- Training Participants are able to identify which tools can be used for specific budget analysis purposes and propose additional research methodologies and adaptations to provide the needed evidence and information for policy advocacy purposes.
- Training Participants are enhanced understanding on the processes and mechanisms of gender responsive budgeting to be carried in the context based and unique manner and Enhanced understanding of budget actors and their different roles in order to identify entry points for GRB in budget processes and budget cycles.
- Enhanced understanding on the links between gender budgeting and wider changing trends and demands- the gender budgeting toolkit available to budget stakeholders, including gender budgeting statements, gender impact assessments, gender focused fiscal reporting, etc.
- Enhanced understanding of the participants on the classification of different budgets and identifying the potential of gender analysis of each of them. Enhanced Interest and commitment in incorporating gender responsive budgeting concepts into policy advocacy and programming for gender equality.
- Enhanced understanding of the participants to review processes and roles and responsibilities of various stakeholders in examining ways by which mainstream governance institutions can be responsive and accountable to Gender Equality concerns.
